Dear colleagues,

Let us start by wishing you a very warm welcome to Bordeaux for the “Diophantine Geometry and L-functions: Hindry 65” conference. This document gathers some information about the program.

1. Location: all the talks will be given in the Salle de Conférence of the Institut Mathématiques de Bordeaux. This is the main conference room, located at the entrance of the Mathematical Institute, in the building A33, on the University campus of Talence. The closest tram stops are on Ligne B: Forum and Peixotto.
2. Time frame: we start on Monday at 9:00 with the registration, in front of the conference room, where you will get your badge, among other useful things. The schedule for the conference will then be the following:

3. Coffee breaks: it will be served in front of the conference room. You will get a cup that you can keep and reuse, if you want to clean it from time to time it will be possible in the “salle de détente”, next to the conference room.
4. Lunch breaks: the lunch breaks are rather long for two reasons: first, you will have the time to discuss a bit with your colleagues! Second, you will have the time to walk out and find a restaurant around campus. Here are some options:

 - Sur le pouce (sandwich), 451, cours de la Libération.
 - Bistro Régent Talence (grill), 1, place de l’Eglise, allée du 7ème art.
 - Yamato (Asian), 20, allée du 7ème art.
 - Edwood Café (American), 1, place Alcalá de Henares.
 - Twist’n’Crêpes (crêperie), 329, cours de la Libération.
 - L’Alcalá (Italian), place Alcalá de Henares.
 - Santosha Talence (Asian), 337, cours de la Libération.
 - Carpe Diem (French), 100, avenue Roul, 33400 Talence.
 - Joya Talence (French), 283, cours de la Libération.
 - Halles Biltoki de Talence (several restaurants!), 316 bis, cours de la Libération, place Alcalá de Henares.
 - Note: we will also provide some tickets for the canteen, which is located nearby. It serves decent food, but it comes with small drawbacks: waiting time can be a bit long, and there is no reserved tables for us. If you need a ticket, ask the organizers.

5. Welcome cocktail: on Monday at 18:30, you are invited to a “cocktail de bienvenue”, which will take place in the Atrium of the University of Bordeaux at Place de La Victoire, downtown Bordeaux. The nearest tram stop is on Ligne B: Victoire. Some drinks and small appetizers will be served. It should last until around 20:30. After that, you will be free to walk in the city, try out a restaurant or a bar. If you intend to eat out with many friends, we advise you to call in advance to book a table. Ask the locals for tips, or consult gastronomy websites, there are many options downtown Bordeaux!
6. Photo: we will take a conference picture on Tuesday 27/09. Now you know, in case you want to dress up :)
7. Excursion: we will take a bus to go to Saint-Emilion and spend the afternoon. The ride is approximately one hour. When we reach the town, you will be free to visit at your pace. There are many wine tasting options in Saint-Emilion, and if you come in smaller groups (say 4 people), they often let you try their wine for free! You can also visit the monolithic church, the cloister, the tower of the city, the surrounding vineyards, the macaron shop. There are guided tours available, both in English and French, if you want to book one you may simply contact the tourist office: <https://www.saint-emilion-tourisme.com/uk/infos-pratiques/horaires.html>. Only the bus ride is covered by the conference funds, though. Return trip: the bus will leave Saint-Emilion at around 19:00 and reach Bordeaux at around 20:00.
8. Conference dinner: the restaurant is named Le Café du Port, and is located by the river, downtown Bordeaux. We will have a nice moment of celebration. They will serve a set menu, so if there are any constraints on your side, you should have answered the organizers’ email. Also, if you intend to come with your partner, you should have let the organizers know by answering their email. You should always answer the organizers’ emails by the way. And wish them luck, joy, and good health!
